Katie's Company Commentary

Box has established itself as enterprise file-storage company, but where its real market opportunity is for enterprise content-management. ECM (Enterprise Content Management) includes sophisticated permissions and compliance features used by virtually all mid and enterprise sized organizations across all industries. Dropbox was never able to accomplish this and it has impacted their market cap.

Levie said on the most recent earnings call, Box is riding the wave of *"a multi-year secular shift from legacy enterprise content management solutions and storage technology in the on-premises environment to the cloud."* Levie continued, *"We believe we're best positioned to be able to take advantage of that migration."*

Super important to know that Box is positioned in (Gartner) Leaders Quadrant for the fourth consecutive year. Also, interesting to note that they've formed a partnership with Google for image recognition and machine learning. *"Box's application of Google Cloud's machine learning APIs brings to life the potential of AI in the enterprise,"* said Fei-Fei Li, Chief Scientist, Google Cloud AI and Professor of Computer Science, Stanford University.
